League: All age divisions will participate in an in-house league. No scores (wins or losses) will be recorded. This league is designed purely for fun and development, so please keep that in mind when deciding to participate.

Coaches: Our teams are coached by volunteer parents of our participants. If you're interested in helping as a coach, please let us know—little to no prior experience is required. Parent involvement is essential to making this program successful. All volunteer coaches must pass the required City of Bellaire background check.

Uniforms: Every participant will receive a jersey

Equipment: Tennis shoes or soccer cleats (are not required). Shin guards are recommended but not required.

Team Pictures & Rewards: Awards will be determined by each individual team. A date will be scheduled for a professional photographer to take team photos, and coaches will share the details with their teams once it is confirmed.

Team Assignments

Players from last season will not necessarily be placed on the same team from year to year. Special requests for friends or practices will **NOT** be honored. You will receive communication from your coach who will give you the details about practices and other information.

Practice & Game Details

Practices: Are held once a week. They will be held either 4:30PM-5:30PM or 5:30PM-6:30 PM, Monday through Friday. All practices and games will be played at Feld Park (6406 Avenue B)

Games: 1 game per week. Games will be held at Feld Park on Saturdays tentatively from 8am-2pm

- 4-5 years old 8am-11am
- 6-7 years old 8am-12pm
- 8-10 years old 11am-2pm

Game Play: 4-5/6-7 division will play with a size 3 soccer ball and 8-10 division will play with a size 4 soccer ball

What if it rains?

- On practice days when the city does not close the fields due to poor conditions, the decision to hold practice will be made by your coach. If multiple practices are missed in a row, the coach may choose to reschedule a practice for another day. If you are unsure whether practice will be held, please contact your coach.
- On Saturdays, please arrive at the field approximately 30 minutes before your scheduled game unless your coach notifies you of a cancellation. Coaches will communicate any rainouts or weather-related changes. If you have questions regarding practices or games, please contact your coach.

Rescheduled Games: We will only reschedule one weekend of rainout games. As a result, when it rains, we will make every effort to play games on wet fields as long as conditions are safe. One weekend at the end of the season is reserved as a makeup date for any games that must be canceled due to rain.
